

Consent to your practitioner handling your personal data

In compliance with General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) 2018, the personal information held about you will be kept confidential. By signing the consent form, you are deemed to have given consent, within the meaning of GDPR 2018, for the processing of your personal information for your healthcare needs.

It is intended to keep your data for a minimum of 8 years. You have the right to withdraw consent and access to your data.

You consent and agree to your practitioner:

- Recording and processing your data for your healthcare needs.
- Communicating with ABC (Miriam Kmetova, DC, MChiro) by email/text e.g. for appointments and in some cases transferring information by letter or email.
- Sharing information with other healthcare practitioners that may be involved in your care.
- Sharing information where applicable with your insurance company.
- At times a third party may have access to your data such as another practitioner or a computer technician, or virtual receptionist.
- In the event of transfer of the practice you understand that your data may be shared with the purchaser.
- You are responsible for informing of any changes in data including name, address, contact numbers, email etc.

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
